INVOCATION WAS GIVEN BY INMAN RESIDENT KEN DITTEMORE AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE BY COUNCILMEMBER KEVIN NEWMAN.

MAYOR HUFF CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER.

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION STATEMENT WAS READ BY MAYOR HUFF CONCERNING NOTIFICATION OF THIS MEETING.

COUNCILMEMBERS MELVIN FOWLER, KEVIN NEWMAN AND HEATHER MOORE WERE PRESENT.

COUNCILMEMBER NEWMAN MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE AGENDA, SECOND TO THE MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMEMBER FOWLER, MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL VOTING.

COUNCILMEMBER MOORE MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE MINUTES OF THE JANUARY 11, 2021 REGULAR MEETING, SECOND TO THE MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMEMBER FOWLER, MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL VOTING.

COUNCILMEMBER NEWMAN MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE FIRST READING OF ORDINANCE NO. 2021-03, AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 26 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE CITY OF INMAN: "TRAFFIC AND MOTOR VEHICLES," SECOND TO THE MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMEMBER FOWLER, MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL VOTING.

COUNCILMEMBER NEWMAN MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE FIRST READING OF ORDINANCE NO. 2021-04, An Amendment to the Zoning Ordinance to Amend Article IV: Section 401 R-12, Single Family Low Density Residential District: Section 401.6 Dimensional Requirements; Section 402 R-10, Single Family Medium Density Residential District: Section 402.6 Dimensional Requirements; Section 403 RG General Residential District: Section 403.6 Dimensional Requirements; Section 411 R-4 Single Family Small Lot Residential District: Section 411.6 Dimensional Requirements; and Section 412 R-6 Single Family High Density Residential District: Section 412.6 Dimensional Requirements, second to the motion was made by councilmember Moore, motion carried with all voting.

COUNCILMEMBER NEWMAN MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE FOUR (4) NIGHTS OF "MUSIC ON MILL" STARTING ON JUNE 4, 11, 18, & 25, 2021 USING THE DESIGNATED BUDGET THAT COUNCIL APPROVED FOR THIS YEAR AND CONTINUING WITH THE BAND MANAGER WE'VE USED BEFORE IF HE'S WILLING AND WE'LL TRY TO MOVE FORWARD AS USUAL MINUS THE BOUNCY, SECOND TO THE MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMEMBER MOORE.

CITY ADMINISTRATOR JOE LANAHAN REPORTED THAT OUR ZONING ADMINISTRATOR DENNIS STATON WILL BE LEAVING US ON FEBRUARY 26 AND HE AND ASST CLERK MANDY SHAW WILL BE MEETING WITH RCI WHICH IS A COMPANY THAT HAS WORKED FOR THE CITY BEFORE AND THEY WILL FILL THE ROLE AS ZONING ADMINISTRATOR TEMPORARILY AS WE DECIDE THE BEST WAY TO MOVE FORWARD TO WHAT THAT POSITION NEEDS TO LOOK LIKE FOR THE CITY AND THE EXAMPLE THAT HE IS MOVING FORWARD WITH IS IN GAFFNEY, SC. CC&I AND RCI HAVE WORKED TOGETHER FOR A NUMBER OF YEARS IN THIS CAPACITY AND CC&I HANDLES THE INSPECTIONS OF BUILDINGS AND RCI OPERATES AS THE ZONING ADMINISTRATOR AND THE SCOPE OF THE JOB WILL PROBABLY BE AN HOURLY RATE FOR THIS PERSON AND HE HOPES TO BRING BY THE MARCH MEETING A RECOMMENDATION TO COUNCIL ON HOW TO MOVE FORWARD WITH THE ZONING ADMINITRATOR'S POSITION.

COUNCIL TIME:

COUNCILMEMBER FOWLER SUGGESTED TROTTIN SALLY FOR THE MURAL.

COUNCILMEMBER NEWMAN STATED THAT HE'S GLAD THAT COUNCIL HAD THE RETREAT ON SATURDAY, THE MEETING WITH BOUDREAUX TODAY AND WIL BE WORKING ON MUSIC ON MILL.

MAYOR HUFF STATED THAT HE IS VERY THANKFUL FOR THIS COUNCIL AND THANKFUL FOR STAYING THE COURSE BECAUSE WE GET A LOT OF NEGATIVE STUFF BUT THERE IS A LOT MORE POSITIVE THAN NEGATIVE.
