

**INMAN CITY COUNCIL  
BUDGET WORKSHOP MEETING MINUTES  
MONDAY, JUNE 8, 2020  
INMAN CITY HALL COUNCIL CHAMBERS**

The City of Inman City Council held a budget workshop on Monday, June 8, 2020 at Inman City Hall Council Chambers, 20 S. Main Street, Inman, SC at 6:54 PM. Mayor Huff and Mayor Pro-Tem Melvin Fowler were present, along with Councilmembers Kevin Newman, Ginger Morrow-McGuire, and Heather Moore. Also in attendance was City Administrator Missy House.

Mayor Huff called the meeting to order and read the Freedom of Information Act statement concerning notification of this meeting.

Councilmember McGuire made a motion to approve the agenda. Second to the motion was made by Councilmen Newman. Motion carried with all voting.

Mayor Huff welcomed the group and introduced City Administrator, Missy House, to take the lead in the discussion. Ms. House reiterated her concerns of what effect COVID-19 may have on the City's revenues. Ms. House stated that she was now in possession of information on assessed value and the cap on how much millage rate can be raised in the new budget. The assessed value of all real property in the city limits was up again this to \$8,655,445. The millage rate increase cap is set at 3.7%, or 2.88 mills. Ms. House stated that no lines items were deleted this year, but that there were no funds set aside for big purchases due to the unknown effect that COVID will have on revenue streams. The city administrator recommends no millage rate increase and no cost of living adjustment raise for staff, but would love to find other avenues to compensate staff with extra days of annual leave. Council agreed with Ms. House's assessment and reiterated how hard it is to know how revenues will be impacted, but that they agree that things should be done to help out staff at this time.

Meeting adjourned at 7:32 PM.
