ZOOM MEETING

MAYOR CORNELIUS HUFF CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER.

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION STATEMENT WAS READ BY MAYOR HUFF CONCERNING NOTIFICATION OF THIS MEETING.

INVOCATION WAS GIVEN BY COUNCILMEMBER HEATHER MOORE.

COUNCILMEMBERS KEVIN NEWMAN, GINGER MORROW-MCGUIRE, MELVIN FOWLER AND HEATHER MOORE WERE PRESENT.

COUNCILMEMBER NEWMAN MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE AGENDA, SECOND TO THE MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMEMBER FOWLER, MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL VOTING.

COUNCILMEMBER NEWMAN MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE UP TO \$500 OF HOSPITALITY TAX FUNDS FOR THE GREATER INMAN CHAMBER OF COMMERCE TO DECORATE THE 'WELCOME TO INMAN' SIGNS FOR FALL AND CHRISTMAS AND A MOTION FOR \$1,800 OF HOSPITALITY TAX FUNDS TO PURCHASE NEW CHRISTMAS AND WINTER BANNERS FOR DOWNTOWN STREET LIGHTS, SECOND TO THE MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMEMBER MORROW-MCGUIRE, MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL VOTING.

COUNCILMEMBER NEWMAN MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE \$5,000 OF HOSPITALITY TAX FUNDS FOR THE FIRST 100 BUSINESSES THAT HAVE A BUSINESS LICENSE TO APPLY FOR A CHRISTMAS GRANT FOR \$50 TO HELP DECORATE THEIR BUSINESS AND APPROVE \$350 FOR A RESIDENTIAL LIGHT DECORATING CONTEST WHERE THE WINNER WILL RECEIVE A \$200 GIFT CARD, SECOND PLACE WILL RECEIVE A \$100 GIFT CARD AND THIRD PLACE WILL RECEIVE A \$50 GIFT CARD, SECOND TO THE MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMEMBER FOWLER, MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL VOTING.

INTERIM CITY ADMINISTRATOR TREY EUBANKS WILL RESEARCH COMPANIES THAT WILL PROVIDE A DISPLAY FOR FALL AND CHRISTMAS AND BRING THIS INFORMATION TO COUNCIL AT THE NOVEMBER MEETING.

MAYOR HUFF MADE A MOTION TO CANCEL ALL EVENTS FOR 2020 AND MAKE 2021 THE BEST YEAR YET, SECOND TO THE MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMEMBER FOWLER, MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL VOTING.

AT 5:35 PM COUNCILMEMBER NEWMAN MADE A MOTION TO GO INTO EXECUTIVE SESSION TO DISCUSS A PROPOSED CONTRACTUAL ARRANGEMENT AND A PERSONNEL MATTER, SECOND TO THE MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMEMBER FOWLER, MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL VOTING.

COUNCILMEMBER NEWMAN MADE A MOTION TO GO OUT OF EXECUTIVE SESSION AND BACK INTO THE SPECIAL MEETING, SECOND TO THE MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMEMBER FOWLER, MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL VOTING.

MAYOR HUFF STATED THAT NO DECISIONS WERE MADE IN EXECUTIVE SESSION.
