ZOOM MEETING**

MAYOR HUFF CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER.

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION STATEMENT WAS READ BY MAYOR HUFF CONCERNING NOTIFICATION OF THIS MEETING.

INVOCATION WAS GIVEN BY MINISTER WILLIE HINES.

COUNCILMEMBERS HEATHER MOORE, MELVIN FOWLER, GINGER MORROW-MCGUIRE AND KEVIN NEWMAN WERE PRESENT.

COUNCILMEMBER NEWMAN MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE AGENDA, SECOND TO THE MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMEMBER FOWLER, MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL VOTING.

COUNCILMEMBER NEWMAN MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE REPLACING THE DOWNTOWN BANNERS FOR A COST OF \$1,926 TO BE PAID OUT OF THE HOSPITALITY TAX FUNDS, SECOND TO THE MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMEMBER MORROW-MCGUIRE, MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL VOTING.

COUNCILMEMBER FOWLER MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE PURCHASING A FACE MASK FOR THE CHAPMAN HIGH SCHOOL FOOTBALL TEAM THAT SAYS "WELCOME TO INMAN" FOR A COST OF \$900 TO BE PAID OUT OF HOSPITALITY TAX FUNDS, SECOND TO THE MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMEMBER NEWMAN, MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL VOTING.

INTERIM CITY ADMINISTRATOR TREY EUBANKS STATED THAT MR. BILL HOLLAND HAS SERVED OUR CITY AS THE POLICE CHAPLIN FOR TWO AND A HALF DECADES WITH GREAT AMOUNT OF SERVICE AND DUE TO HIS AGE THE POLICE CHIEF HAS SPOKEN WITH TWO OTHER GENTLEMEN THAT ARE WILLING TO STEP IN TO THAT ROLE. WE ARE VERY GRATEFUL FOR THE COMMITMENT THAT BILL HOLLAND HAS MADE TO THE CITY BECAUSE THERE ARE TIMES WHEN THE POLICE OFFICERS HAVE TO DEAL WITH TRAGEDIES AND HAVING A CHAPLIN THERE TO PRAY WITH THEM AND CONSULT THEM IS A TREMENDOUS SERVICE. MAYOR HUFF INTRODUCED PASTOR WESLEY CAMPBELL AND MINISTER WILLIE HINES AND COUNCILMEMBER NEWMAN MADE A MOTION TO APPOINT THEM AS CITY OF INMAN CHAPLINS, SECOND TO THE MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMEMBER MORROW-MCGUIRE, MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL VOTING.

AT 6:18 PM COUNCILMEMBER NEWMAN MADE A MOTION TO GO INTO EXECUTIVE SESSION FOR DISCUSSION OF NEGOTIATIONS INCIDENT TO PROPOSED CONTRACTUAL ARRANGEMENTS, SECOND TO THE MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMEMBER FOWLER, MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL VOTING.

AT 6:52 PM MAYOR HUFF MADE A MOTION TO GO OUT OF THE EXECUTIVE SESSION AND BACK INTO THE SPECIAL MEETING, SECOND TO THE MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMEMBER FOWLER, MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL VOTING.

MAYOR HUFF STATED THAT COUNCIL DISCUSSED A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT BUT NO DECISIONS WERE MADE.

WITH NO OTHER BUSINESS MAYOR HUFF ADJOURNED THE MEETING AT 6:53 PM.
