MAYOR CORNELIUS HUFF CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER.

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION STATEMENT WAS READ BY MAYOR HUFF CONCERNING NOTIFICATION OF THIS MEETING.

COUNCILMEMBERS KATHY DITTEMORE, HEATHER MOORE, KEVIN NEWMAN AND MELVIN FOWLER WERE PRESENT.

COUNCILMEMBER NEWMAN MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE AGENDA, SECOND TO THE MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMEMBER DITTEMORE, MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL VOTING.

CITY ADMINISTRATOR JOE LANAHAN PRESENTED THE PROPOSED BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 AND STATED THAT THE ITEMS THAT HAVE BEEN ADDED FOR THIS YEAR ARE: COVERING THE COST OF HEALTH INSURANCE FOR FULL-TIME STAFF FOR EMPLOYEE ONLY; THE ADDITION OF A CODES OFFICER POSITION TO WORK WITH ALL OF OUR DEPARTMENTS TO ENFORCE CODES; ADDING A NEW FULL-TIME POSITION TO THE STREET DEPARTMENT TO HELP MAINTAIN A HIGH LEVEL OF ATTENTION TO OUR CITY PROPERTIES, STREETSAPES, RIGHT OF WAYS, AND NEIGHBORHOODS; INCREASE THE WAGE FOR THE PLANNING COMMISSION MEMBERS;AND A HOSPITALITY TAX BOND FOR PROJECTS- MILL STREET PAVILION & RESTROOM, ALLEY RENOVATION ON MAIN ST., ALLEY RESTORATION IN DOWNTOWN, AND EXTEND STREETS SCAPE TWO BLOCKS FURTHER DOWN PROSPECT ST (HWY 292). JOE ALSO STATED THAT A NEW CITY ORGANIZATIONAL CHART SHOWS THE CREATION OF A PUBLIC WORKS DIVISION WHICH WILL BE MADE UP BY THE WASTEWATER DEPARTMENT AND THE STREETS DEPARTMENT.

AT 7:06 PM COUNCILMEMBER FOWLER MADE A MOTION TO GO INTO EXECUTIVE SESSION FOR DISCUSSION OF EMPLOYMENT, APPOINTMENT, COMPENSATION, PROMOTION, DEMOTION, DISCIPLINE, OR RELEASE OF AN EMPLOYEE, SECOND TO THE MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMEMBER DITTEMORE, MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL VOTING.

AT 7:34 PM COUNCILMEMBER DITTEMORE MADE A MOTION TO GO OUT OF EXECUTIVE SESSION AND BACK TO THE SPECIAL MEETING, SECOND TO THE MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMEMBER MOORE, MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL VOTING.
